

# BUGS TEACHER LESSON



### **WARM-UP PLAY**

Parents and children share picture books.

Parents follow their children's lead in play.

Staff mingles with parents asking, "What's new?"

### **GATHERING AND SETTLING**

© Parents and staff sing song while helping children to clean up.

### CLEAN-UP

Clean up, clean up, everybody, everywhere. Clean up, clean up, everybody do your share.

> Praise your child. Hug, kiss, smile, and say, "Hip, hip, hooray!"

### All greet one another by shaking hands and singing the "Hello" song.

#### HELLO

Tune: She'll Be Coming Round The Mountain!

Oh, it's time to say hello to our friends. (Repeat) Wave your hands and say hello. (Repeat) Oh, it's time to say hello to our friends.

### WELCOME SONGS

Parents and staff sing each child's name during the song.

#### OH. HERE WE ARE TOGETHER

Tune: The More We Get Together

Oh, here we are together, together, together.
Oh, here we are together at \_\_\_\_\_ School.
Here's \_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_ and \_\_\_ etc.
Oh, here we are together at School.

Parents face children toward them and hug and kiss while singing.

#### WE LOVE CHILDREN

Tune: Are You Sleeping?

We love children. Children are for hugging.
We love children. Children are for kissing.
Yes we do. Yes we do. We love you. Yes we do!

### PREVIEW AND CIRCLE TIME

Staff uses props and pictures to prepare children and parents for the playgroup activities.

### **BABY BUMBLEBEE**

Tune: Traditional

I'm bringing home a baby bumblebee, Wont my mama be so proud of me. I'm bringing home a baby bumblebee, Bzzz bzzz It stung me!

Pass out yellow and black pom poms to children.

### **ITSY BITSY SPIDER**

Finger Play

Itsy bitsy Spider,
Went up the water spout.
Down came the rain and,
Washed the spider out.
Out came the sun and dried up all the rain,
And the itsy bitsy spider

And the itsy bitsy spider
Went up the spout again
Passout spiders rings and gesture

to finger play.

**Group Movement Activity** 

Turn the lights out. Parents hold parachute aloft while children run under with flashlights like fireflies.

Play techno background music.

### CREATIVE PLAY STATIONS

Free play with theme puzzles, playdoh, duplo bug set and bubbles

C Staff briefly describes the play stations that are set up throughout the room. Parents follow their children's lead as they explore the play stations.

# **DIGGING FOR WORMS**Messy Play

Children and parents play together at a sensory table filled with dirt shovels and plastic worms. Add a variety of paper cups for in and out play.

# **UVELY LADY BUGS**Creative Play

Children stamp black dots on red ladybug shapes. Use glue sticks. Label with child's name and send home.

# WOUNG ENTOMOLOGISTS Communication/Pretend Play

Children and parents look at pretend and real insects under magnifying glasses. Use the words "big" and "little."

# COCOON Active Play

Children crawl through tunnel and emerge as a butterfly. Drape multicolored scarves at the tunnel exit.

### **SNACK TIME**

Children, parents, and staff wash hands. Serve snacks individually as the children are seated at the table.

String cheese "worms" with butterfly crackers and juice.

### TRANSTION AND FREE CHOICE PLAY

Staff supports parents as children are prepared for transition. Parents depart for parent education group. Staff follows children's lead as they repeat activities at a creative play station, play with toys throughout the room, go for a walk or a buggy ride, or look at books. Children listen to a variety of types of music as they play.

### **REGATHERING ACTIVITIES**

### **O** RING AROUND THE ROSIE

Ring around the rosie, pockets full of posies, Children, children, we all fall down.

### **OPEN SHUT THEM**

Open, shut them, open, shut them, give a little clap, clap, clap. Open, shut them, open, shut them, put them in your lap, lap, lap.

### SHARE A BOOK ABOUT INSECTS

Tell the story in simple words. Talk about the pictures and ask questions.

### **REVIEW**

Staff reviews the playgroup activities with the children and individually shares with parents what their children did during the parent education group.

### **HOME PLAY**

Tatch an insect with your child in an unbreakable jar. Study it and then let it go free.
