Staff uses props and pictures to prepare children and parents for the playgroup activities.

🎆 BUS STOP **Communication/Pretend Play**

Children and parents roll toy cars and school buses along a tape road. Stop and pick up toy people. Use the words "stop", "go," "fast," and "slow."



Children push cars up ramps and let them roll down. Provide cardboard boxes for garages.

SNACK TIME

Children, parents, and staff wash hands. Serve snacks individually as the children are seated at the table. Cheese slice "car" with round cracker "wheels" and water bottle

TRANSTION AND FREE CHOICE PLAY

🔋 Staff supports parents as children are prepared for transition. Parents depart for parent education group. Staff follows children's lead as they repeat activities at a creative play station, play with toys throughout the room, go for a walk or a buggy ride, or look at books. Children listen to a variety of types of music as they play.
