Children and parents clean up the housekeeping center. Provide dusters, scrub brushes, buckets of water and tov vacuum cleaners. Use the words "clean" and "dirty."

Children explore a pile of mixed plastic spoons, forks and knives. Children dump and fill or sort plastic silverware into three different boxes.
