CIRCLE TIME

Rub sandpaper blocks together to rhyme.

FLYING AROUND **Group Movement Activity**

Children fly around the room pretending to be airplanes. Children hold pinwheel propellers as they fly.

Fly to big band background music.

CREATIVE PLAY STATIONS

Free play with theme puzzles, playdoh, magnetic blocks, and bubbles



Children and parents play together at a sensory table filled with white cottonball "clouds." Provide a variety of toy airplanes and box lid landing pads. Add tongs.



Children use dot painters and stamp on construction paper "train tickets." Label with child's name and take home.



Children and parents connect toy train tracks. Children move trains along tracks. Use the words "short," "long," "stop," and "go."

PACKING TO GO Active Play

Parents and children fill duffel bags with clothing and load into a wagon luggage cart.

Vanilla pudding "cloud" with airplane shaped cookie and milk

HOME PLAY

Praise your child. Hug, kiss, smile, and say, "You're on Track!"
