

TRUCKS **PARENT HANDOUT**

CIRCLE TIME

BIG TRUCK, LITTLE TRUCK Rhythmic Chant

Big truck, big truck, how do you go? Forward, backward, fast or slow. *Little truck, little truck, how do you go?* Forward, backward, fast or slow.

TEST DRIVE Group Movement Activity

Children and parents pretend to drive around obstacles. Use orange construction cones, wedges, and "speed bumps."

Pass out keys on a key ring. Shake keys to rhyme.

Play country background music.

CREATIVE PLAY STATIONS

Free play with theme puzzles, playdoh, roadway blocks y bubbles

MOVING DAY Communication/Pretend Play

Children and parents put doll house furniture in trucks and push around the room. Stop at the doll house and unload the furniture. Use the words "in" and "out."

O LOADING DOCK Active Play

Children and parents work together and "load" and "unload" milk containers in plastic crates. Fill empty jugs with varying amounts of water.

CONSTRUCTION SITE Messy Play

Take your child on a walk. Point out different kinds of trucks. Look for dump trucks, delivery trucks and mail trucks.
